Pharmacological treatment of Conduct Disorder, Therapy treatment for Conduct Disorders

Treatment Summary: There are two commonly used ways to treat someone with conduct disorder. One way is the pharmacological treatment in which the person is given different is given a prescription based on the severity and/or type of behavior they are encountering.
