## **HURRICANE HELENE PROVIDER UPDATE #1**

As you are likely aware, yesterday Gov. Roy Cooper declared a State of Emergency for North Carolina. Hurricane Helene will make landfall in Florida later today. Most predictions have this storm bringing torrential rains to Western and Central North Carolina, but due to our recent storms, most of our regions will feel the impacts due to the ground being saturated. Tornado risks are possible throughout our state, as well. Be sure to have your alerts active on your phones.
